# North Carolina laws\* allow the following amounts of alcohol to be purchased and transported without a permit:

## BEER - Maximum of 80 liters in cans or bottles

- (9) cases and (9) cans/bottles - 355 milliliter (12oz.)
- (7) cases and (1) can/bottle - 473 milliliter (16oz.)
- Kegs - unlimited

## UNFORTIFIED WINE *(16% or less alcohol by volume)* – Maximum of 50 liters

- (10) 5 liter containers
- (50) 1 liter bottles
- (66) 750 milliliter bottles
- (28) 1.75 liter bottles

## SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR & FORTIFIED WINE *(16-24% alcohol by volume)* – Maximum of 8 Liters

- 8 liters of only spirituous liquor or fortified wine
- 8 liters of a combination of spirituous liquor and fortified wine
