ALCOHOL PURCHASE & TRANSPORTATION AMOUNTS





North Carolina laws* allow the following amounts of alcohol to be purchased and transported without a permit:

BEER - Maximum of 80 liters in cans or bottles

- (9) cases and (9) cans/bottles 355 milliliter (12oz.)
- (7) cases and (1) can/bottle 473 milliliter (16oz.)
- Kegs unlimited

UNFORTIFIED WINE (16% or less alcohol by volume) – Maximum of 50 liters

• (10) 5 liter containers

• (50) 1 liter bottles

• (66) 750 milliliter bottles

• (28) 1.75 liter bottles

SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR & FORTIFIED WINE (16-24% alcohol by volume) – Maximum of 8 Liters

- 8 liters of only spirituous liquor or fortified wine
- 8 liters of a combination of spirituous liquor and fortified wine



To purchase more than the stated amounts of unfortified wine. fortified wine. and spirituous liquor, you must receive a purchasetransportation permit from your local ABC store.
