ABC COMMISSION TAKES ACTION ON 46 PERMIT VIOLATIONS

RALEIGH – The three-member North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission today levied more than \$55,000 in fines or suspensions of five days or more on representatives of 46 clubs, convenience stores, restaurants and other businesses holding permits to sell alcohol in North Carolina. Fines begin Oct. 11 and suspensions Oct. 18.

The Commission set a special meeting date of October 9 at 10 a.m. to consider adoption of the proposed temporary rules regarding sales of beer in stands at professional sporting events and the filling and refilling of growlers on demand.

The Commission also unanimously approved exemption requests by Devil's Distillery of Pittsboro and Westgate Wine of Raleigh.

North Carolina is one of 17 states to regulate alcohol through a control system. Since 1937, the North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission has provided regulation and control over the sale, purchase, transportation, manufacture, consumption and possession of alcoholic beverages in the state of North Carolina.
