**NC ABC COMMISSION SUSPENDS PERMITS OF GOLDSBORO BUSINESS AFTER WEEKEND SHOOTING**

RALEIGH – A shooting at a Goldsboro business September 7 resulting in injuries has prompted the NC ABC Commission to order the immediate suspension of the alcohol permits held by the business. The shooting at the location was the second in three months, according to sworn statements of law enforcement officers.

Bee's Town, at 905 South Slocumb Street, Goldsboro, has held its current ABC permits since Oct. 28, 2013.

According to affidavits of law enforcement officers, officers have responded to numerous service calls at the business related to shootings, fights and drug violations.

The summary suspension is immediate and is in effect until the case is heard by the Office of Administrative Hearings. The action is authorized under N.C. General Statute 150B-3(c), which states: "The proceedings shall be promptly commenced and determined."

This is the second summary suspension issued this year by the NC ABC Commission and is part of the Commission's ongoing focus on public health and public safety.
